Hey Mainstream class members, Valentine's Day, February 14th, 2012 so happens to fall on our TUESDAY! Many people that have met in the square class classes, end up tying the knot and have stayed together ever since. Please, please.... may I make it clear that the chances are usually good, NOT a promise.

The Mainstream class is getting better, smoother and moving to the beat of the music. Keep up the good pace, practice and you will enjoy more as a result. Please be aware that in any club sponsored classes, it is common to be short of male dancers and do have folks called "Class Coordinators" to find you a partner as well as keeping the squares well balanced with experienced dancers and class dancers.

Please inform the Class Coordinators of any suggestions or possible safety issues that may arise. Please rest assured that SAFETY COMES FIRST and would be greatly appreciated. If you find someone in the square that may be a safety issue, please let the Class Coordinators know soon as possible and we will talk to that dancer(s). Please don't worry about the "Who reported who." What's most important is that anyone can get a little carried away with joy on occasion and we're all human. Please inform Viva Johnson or Steve Green or someone at the "Sign-in" table and the message will get through A.S.A.P. Once again, feel free to be stylistic in your dancing, but safe.

Most attentive LISTENERS are often some of the safest square dancers because they rarely miss any 'calls' and obviously would not need to race through the square to execute them. Missing the instructor's calls can cause everyone in the square to have collision or trip over each other's feet to make up lost time to perform the calls.

Many thanks to the many Angels & Callers that have requested me to emphasize greater safety practice in this corner. Please use T-O-U-C-H in hand to hand contact calls as it would be easier smoother and less chance of hurting someone's fingers, hands or wrists from squeezing or gripping too hard. Using "THUMB HOOKING" in the Swing Through can be extremely hazardous. All it takes is one dancer to slip & fall in an Ocean Wave or Alamo Ring and you may hear &/or feel a chain reaction of CRRaaccckk, Ccrraaccckk, Ccrraaccckk... in the thumb joints! Attention PLUS Class Members - Thumb Hooking while performing Relay the Deucey, Spin Chain the Gears or even when Centers Trade in Acey Deucey can be treacherous.

Please Promenade Home as close to the center of the square as possible. Otherwise, the promenading couple(s) could have a collision with, or ending up in, a neighboring square or both!

Many Thanks to Caller John Hyde in promoting smoothness as well as safety. Attention Everyone - Be on alert for dancers who do not wish to swing at all. Some dancers can get dizzy while swinging and especially from twirling.

Thanks also to our VT Angels, Charles & Michelle, for bringing feedbacks from the Mainstream Class for the Safety Corner.

Happy Valentine's Day to our legendary Plus Class Members! There are many square dancers that started as teenagers, later tied the knot and are still together after many years!

I am so glad that Don Schadt started teaching Tea Cup Chain as early as he did because, in many SD classes sponsored by other clubs, this is done later. Once you've graduated from the PLUS Class and off to any club dances, you may hear the Call, Head Men Center for the Tea Cup Chain. Gentlemen... it's not always the Head Ladies going into the Center and Side Ladies going to their right. Please be aware that Tea Cup Chain can be performed from 2 couple facing lines. Whoa! Yeah!, that does seem like an awkward position to start with. However, the Rules of the call are still the SAME. Again, listen closely to the Caller as there are numerous combinations of starting positions for Tea Cup Chain. A Caller can have one couple Half Sashay and you will have a Gentleman and a Lady going into the Center for Tea Cup Chain instead of two ladies or gentlemen & finding two dancers of opposite genders doing a Turn Through with the dancer on their right side. There are NUMEROUS Combinations of Starting Positions for many square dance calls beside Tea Cup Chain. Please do your best to be on alert for what position you're starting from and where you will end up. I hope you're aware that Load the Boat consists of 4 Mainstream calls that can look like dancers drawing the shape of a canoe, prior to the "Partner Trade."

I have noticed that many people spent time with their families last holiday season and missed quite a few Tuesday sessions. That's OK, because "Family comes first" with the VT's a '2nd family.' Please let Steve know ASAP if there are any Plus calls you missed or need a little more practice with.

All in all, Happy Valentine's Day!

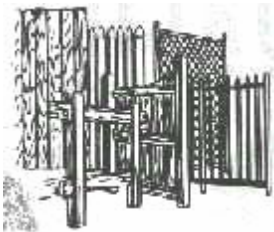
